## Martha's Pantry

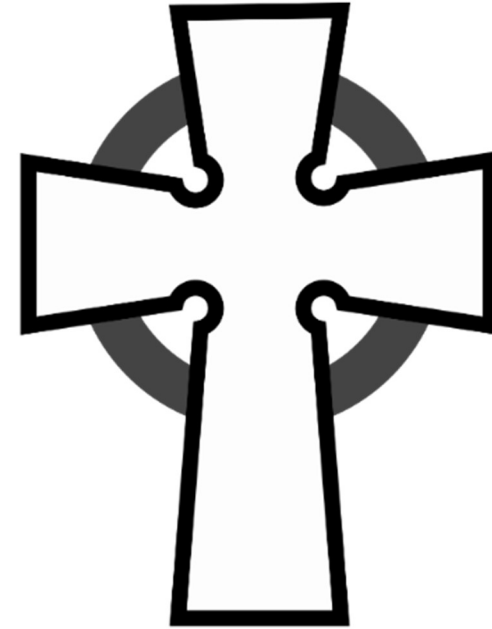
Martha's Pantry operates every second and fourth Tuesday of each month,
